

Middle School Envirothon Rules:

-SUPERVISE YOUR STUDENTS. Each team should have a chaperone to stay with them throughout the day. Your teams will not rotate stations together, and it is the responsibility of the school to provide adequate supervision for its students.

-Chaperones may not assist their teams with the scenario.

-THIS IS A CLOSED-BOOK COMPETITION. Students are encouraged to take notes throughout the day; however, no prepared notes may be brought to the event for use during the scenario preparation.

-NO CELL PHONES. Please ask your students to leave phones on the bus, or a chaperone may hold onto them. If students are found with cell phones during the competition, they risk disqualifying their entire team.

-Teams may not discuss the scenario with anyone but their own teammates until all teams have been judged. Sharing information, eavesdropping, or otherwise interfering with the fairness of the judging procedure is grounds for disqualification.

-A 'HOME BASE' will be designated at the site. Students must always remain in view of home base and may not venture to other areas of the park.
